THURSDAY

SALVATION

2 Corinthians 5:21 God made Jesus, who knew no sin, to be sin on our behalf that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Matthew 6:33 Seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness and all these things shall be added to you.

Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him and He will direct your paths.

FAITH

Romans 10:8-10 The Word is near you, even in your mouth and in your heart; that is, the Word of Faith which we proclaim: if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Psalms 138:2 I praise Your name for Your unfailing love and faithfulness; for Your promises are backed by all the honor of Your name.

OBEDIENCE

Psalms 31:1-3 Lord, I trust in You; let me never be disgraced. Save me because You do what is right. Listen to me and save me quickly. Be my rock of protection, a strong city to save me. You are my rock and my protection. For the good of Your name, lead me and guide me.

Psalms 31:16 Make Your face shine upon Your servant, save me for Your mercies' sake.

Psalms 34:12-15 Does anyone want to live a life that is long and prosperous? Then keep your tongue from speaking evil and your lips from telling lies! Turn away from evil and do good. Search for peace, and work to maintain it. The eyes of the Lord watch over those who do right; His ears are open to their cries for help.

Psalms 34:22 You redeem the soul of Your servants, and none of those who trust in You will be condemned.

Romans 8:1-3 So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus. And because you belong to Him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death. The law of Moses was unable to save us because of the weakness of our sinful nature.

So God did what the law could not do. He sent His own Son in a body like the bodies we sinners have. And in that body God declared an end to sin's control over us by giving His Son as a sacrifice for our sins.

Psalms 31:22 In my distress, I said, "God cannot see me!" But You heard my prayer when I cried out to You for help.

Psalms 37:1-11 Don't worry about the wicked or envy those who do wrong. For like grass, they soon fade away. Like spring flowers, they soon wither. Trust in the Lord and do good. Then you will live safely in the land and prosper. Take delight in the Lord, and He will give you your heart's desires. Commit everything you do to the Lord. Trust Him, and He will help you.

He will make your innocence radiate like the dawn, and the justice of your cause will shine like the noonday sun. Be still in the presence of the Lord, and wait patiently for Him to act. Don't worry about evil people who prosper or fret about their wicked schemes. Stop being angry! Turn from your rage! Do not lose your temper—it only leads to harm. For the wicked will be destroyed, but those who trust in the Lord will possess the land. Soon the wicked will disappear. Though you look for them, they will be gone. The humble will possess the land and will live in peace and prosperity.

Psalms 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

FREEDOM

Psalms 37:24 Though they stumble, they will not fall, for the Lord holds them by His hand.

Ephesians 4:26-27 Don't sin by letting anger control you. Don't let the sun go down while you are still angry, for anger gives a foothold to the devil.

James 1:19-20 You must all be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to get angry. Human anger does not produce the righteousness God desires.

Romans 12:21 Don't let evil conquer you, but conquer evil by doing good.

HEALING

Psalms 30:2 O Lord my God, I cried to You for help, and You restored my health.

Psalms 73:26 My health may fail, and my spirit may grow weak, but God remains the strength of my heart; He is mine forever.

Proverbs 14:30 A peaceful heart leads to a healthy body; jealousy is like cancer in the bones.

Proverbs 17:22 A happy heart is a good medicine, and a cheerful mind works healing, but a broken spirit dries up the bones.

Proverbs 18:21 The tongue can bring death or life; those who love to talk will reap the consequences.

Isaiah 32:3 The eyes of those who see will not be dim, and the ears of those who hear will listen.

Isaiah 40:29 He gives power to the weak and strength to the powerless.

Mark 16:15-18 (Jesus) told them, "Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone. Anyone who believes and is baptized will be saved. But anyone who refuses to believe will be condemned. These miraculous signs will accompany those who believe: they will cast out demons in My name, and they will speak in new languages.

They will be able to handle snakes with safety, and if they drink anything poisonous, it won't hurt them. They will be able to place their hands on the sick, and they will be healed."

Isaiah 58:8 Your light will shine like the dawn, and your wounds will quickly heal. Your God will walk before you, and the glory of the Lord will protect you from behind.

Jeremiah 17:14 Heal me, O Lord, and I shall be healed; save me and I shall be saved, for You are my praise.

Acts 10:38 You know about Jesus from Nazareth, that God gave Him the Holy Spirit and power. You know how Jesus went everywhere doing good and healing those who were ruled by the devil, because God was with Him.

James 5:13-16 Anyone who is having troubles should pray. Anyone who is happy should sing praises. Anyone who is sick should call the church's elders. They should pray for and pour oil on the person in the name of the Lord. And the prayer that is said with faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will heal that person. And if the person has sinned, the sins will be forgiven. Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so God can heal you. When a believing person prays, great things happen.

BLESSINGS

Psalms 23:5 You prepare a feast for me in the presence of my enemies. You honor me by anointing my head with oil. My cup overflows with blessings.

John 10:10 The thief comes to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

Genesis 17:2 God says, "I will make My covenant between Me and you and will multiply you exceedingly."

Luke 2:52 Jesus kept increasing in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man.

Genesis 26:12-14 Then Isaac sowed seed in that land and received in the same year a hundred times as much as he had planted, and the Lord favored him with blessings. And Isaac became great and gained more and more until he became very wealthy and distinguished... and the Philistines envied him.

Isaiah 26:3-4 You, Lord, give true peace to those who depend on You, because they trust You. So, trust the Lord always, because He is our Rock forever.

Psalms 29:11 The Lord will give strength to His people; the Lord blesses His people with peace.

Psalms 7:10 God protects me like a shield; He saves those whose hearts are right.

Psalms 112:1-3 Praise the Lord! Happy are those who respect the Lord, who want what He commands. Their descendants will be powerful in the land; the children of honest people will be blessed. Their houses will be full of wealth and riches, and their goodness will continue forever.

Proverbs 13:21 Trouble always comes to sinners, but good people enjoy success.

Psalms 31:16 Show Your kindness to me, Your servant. Save me because of Your love.

John 14:13-14 (Jesus said), “You can ask for anything in My name, and I will do it, so that the Son can bring glory to the Father. Yes, ask Me for anything in My name, and I will do it!”

PRAISE

Psalms 139:13 You formed my inward parts, You wove me in my mother's womb. I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Marvelous are Your works and my soul knows it very well.

Psalms 139:17 How precious are Your thoughts to me O God, how great is the sum of them! If I should count them, they would outnumber the sand. When I awake, I am still with You.

Psalms 139:23-24 Search me O God, and know my heart, try me and know my anxious thoughts, and see if there is any wicked way in me, and lead me in the everlasting way.

Psalms 147:1 Praise the Lord! For it is good to sing praises to our God; for it is pleasant and praise is beautiful.

Psalms 147:3 God, You heal the broken-hearted and bind up their wounds.

Psalms 147:11 You favor those who fear You, those who wait for Your lovingkindness.

Psalms 149:4 You take pleasure in Your people; You will beautify the afflicted ones with salvation.

Psalms 149:3-6 Praise His name with dancing, accompanied by tambourine and harp. For the Lord delights in His people; He crowns the humble with victory. Let the faithful rejoice that He honors them. Let them sing for joy as they lie on their beds. Let the praises of God be in their mouths, and a sharp sword in their hands.

Psalms 141:2-3 May my prayer be counted as incense before You, the lifting of my hands as the evening offering. Set a guard, O Lord, over my mouth; keep watch over the door of my lips.

PROMISES

Deuteronomy 6:24-25 The Lord our God commanded us to obey all these decrees and to fear Him so He can continue to bless us and preserve our lives, as He has done to this day. For we will be counted as righteous when we obey all the commands the Lord our God has given us.

Ezekiel 36:25-26 For I will gather you up from all the nations and bring you home again to your land. Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean. Your filth will be washed away, and you will no longer worship idols. And I will give you a new heart, and I will put a new spirit in you. I will take out your stony, stubborn heart and give you a tender, responsive heart.

Isaiah 54:10 “For the mountains may move and the hills disappear, but even then My faithful love for you will remain. My covenant of blessing will never be broken,” says the Lord, who has mercy on you.

Job 36:11 If they listen and obey God, they will be blessed with prosperity throughout their lives. All their years will be pleasant.

James 1:5, 12 If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and He will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking. God blesses those who patiently endure testing and temptation. Afterward they will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love Him.

James 4:6–7 God gives grace to the humble. Therefore, submit yourselves to God, resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Hebrews 6:13-20 When God made His promise to Abraham, He backed it to the hilt, putting His own reputation on the line. He said, “I promise that I’ll bless you with everything I have—bless and bless and bless!” Abraham stuck it out and got everything that had been promised to him. When people make promises, they guarantee them by appeal to some authority above them so that if there is any question that they’ll make good on the promise, the authority will back them up.

When God wanted to guarantee His promises, He gave His Word, a rock-solid guarantee—God can't break His Word. And because His Word cannot change, the promise is likewise unchangeable. We who have run for our very lives to God have every reason to grab the promised hope with both hands and never let go. It's an unbreakable spiritual lifeline, reaching past all appearances right to the very presence of God where Jesus, running on ahead of us, has taken up His permanent post as high priest for us. Jeremiah 29:11 “For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the Lord, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.”

2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

Isaiah 54:10-20 “For the mountains may move and the hills disappear, but even then My faithful love for you will remain. My covenant of blessing will never be broken,” says the Lord, who has mercy on you. “O storm-battered city, troubled and desolate!
