Psalms 34:4 I sought the Lord and He answered me: He delivered me from all my fears.


Joshua 1:9 Be strong and courageous. Do not be terrified; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go.

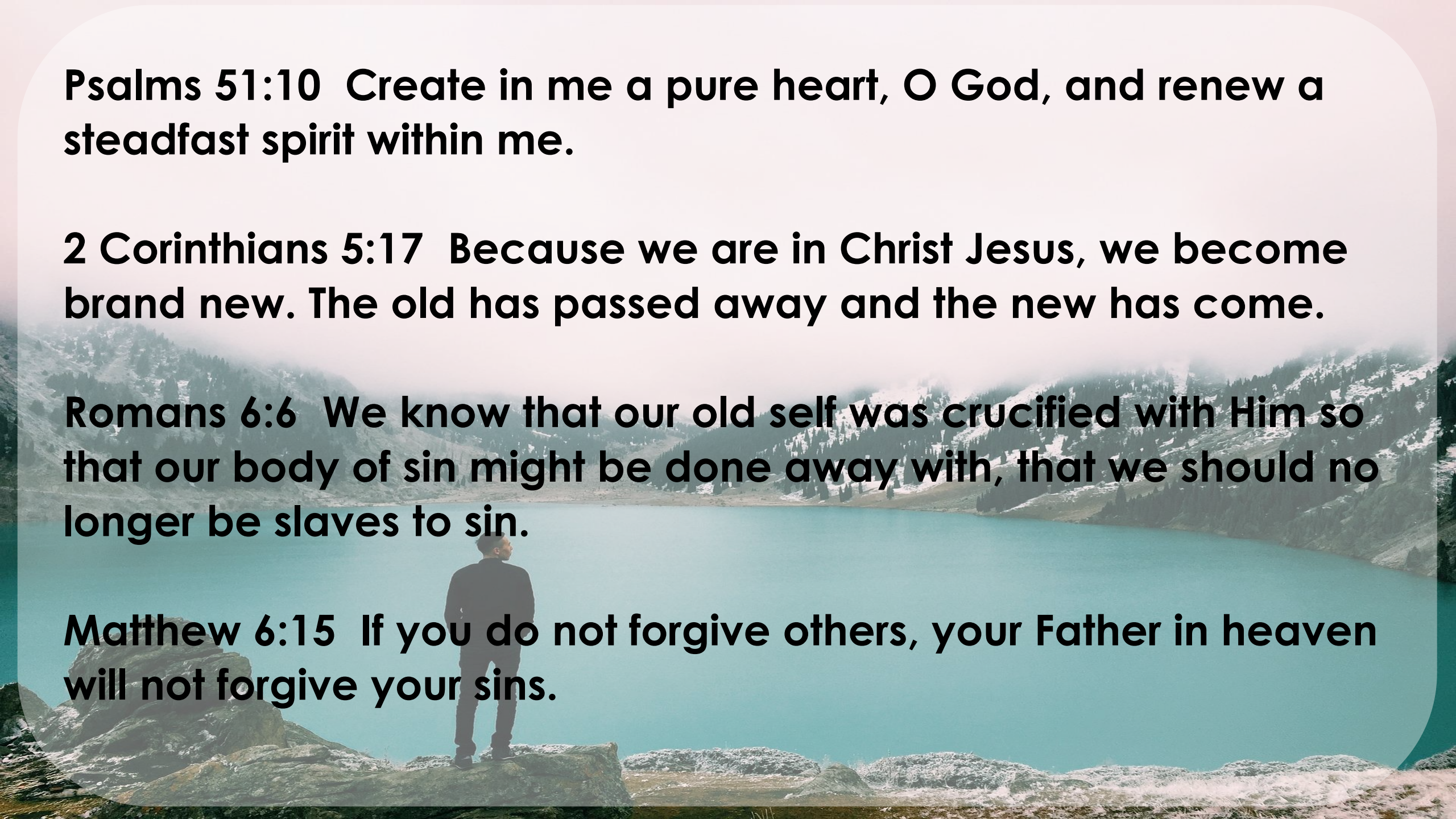

Matthew 6:15 If you do not forgive others, your Father in heaven will not forgive your sins.



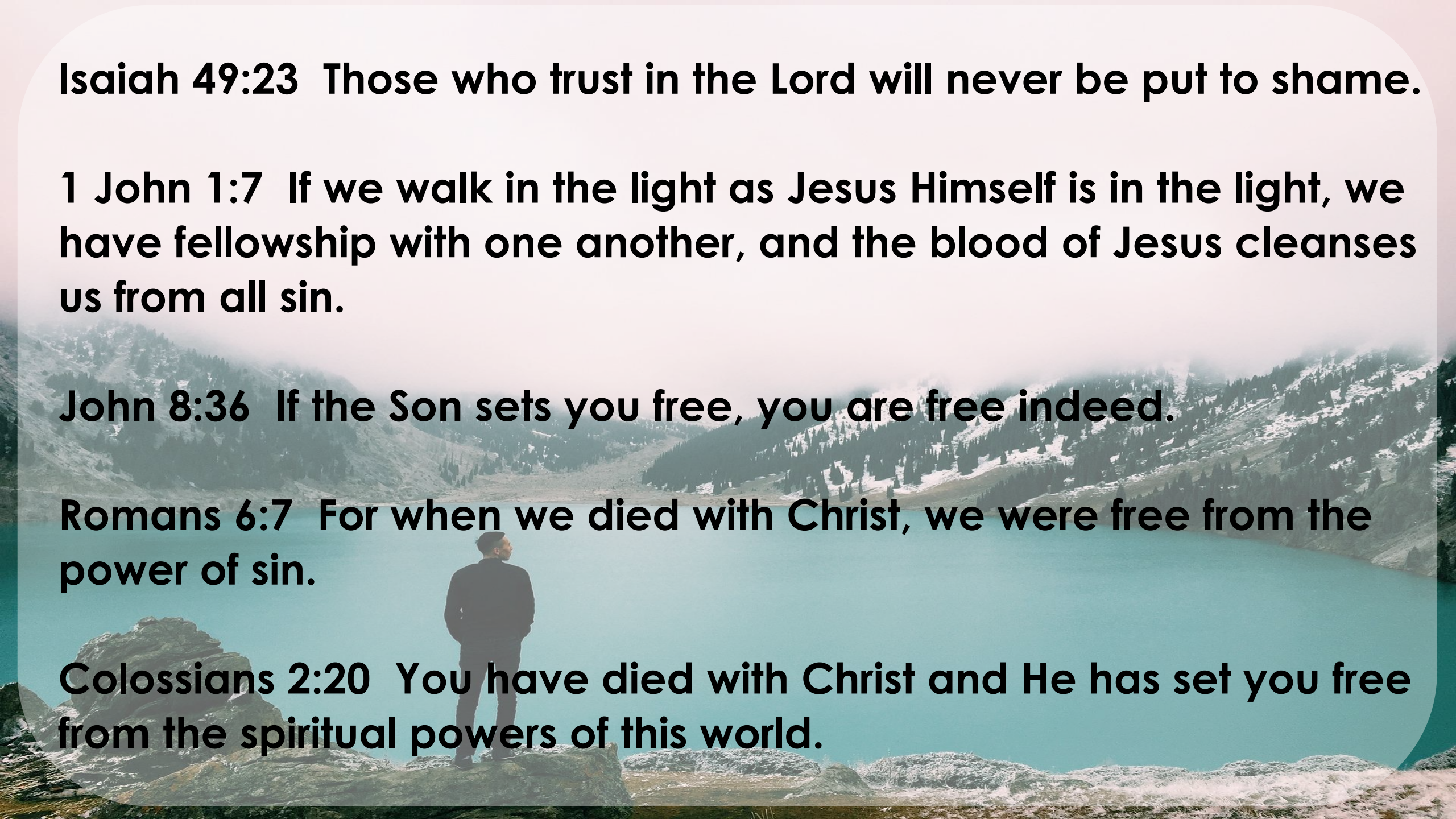
Isaiah 49:23 Those who trust in the Lord will never be put to shame.

Colossians 2:20 You have died with Christ and He has set you free from the spiritual powers of this world.

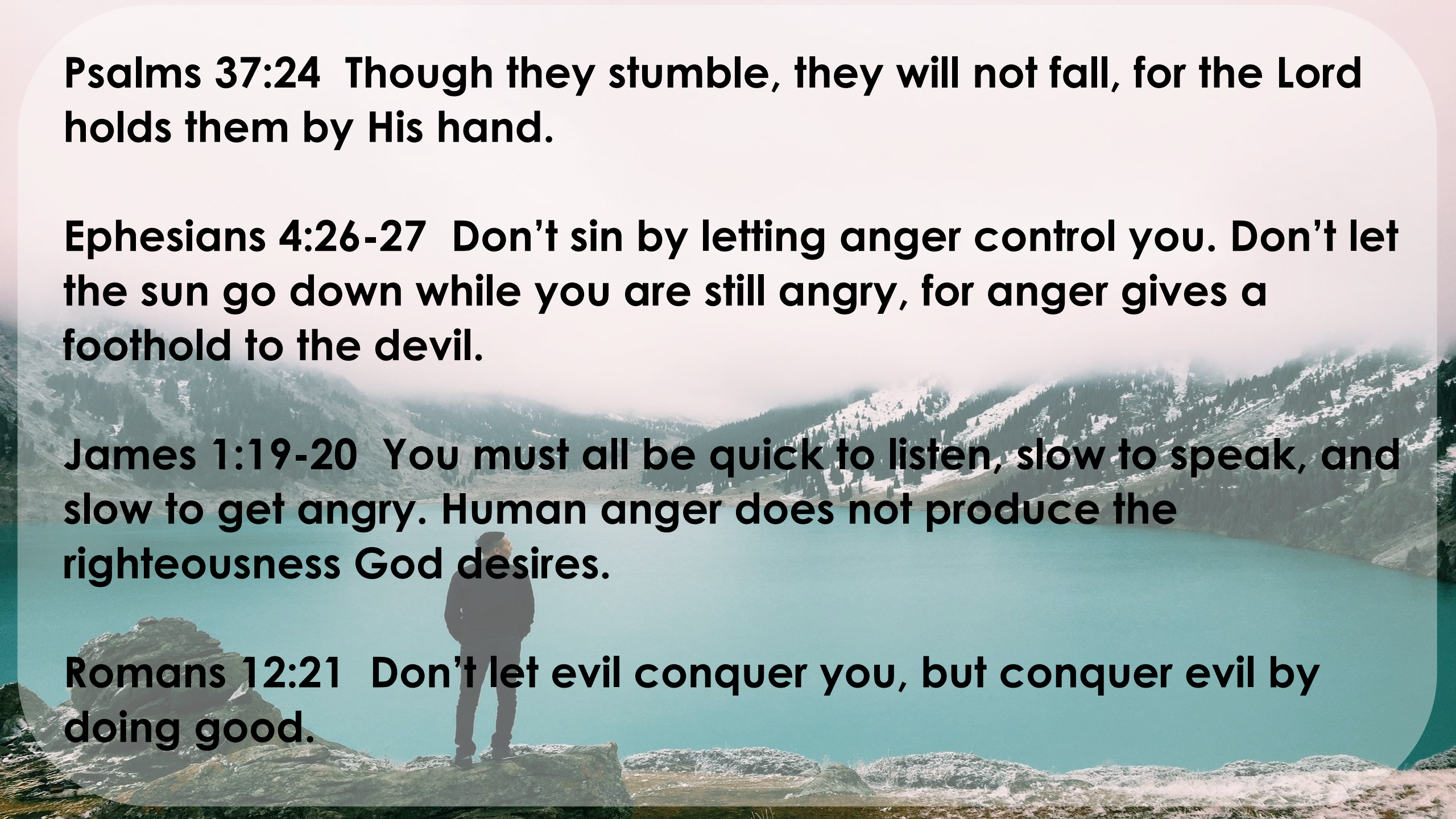


Psalms 37:24 Though they stumble, they will not fall, for the Lord holds them by His hand.

Ephesians 4:26-27 Don't sin by letting anger control you. Don't let the sun go down while you are still angry, for anger gives a foothold to the devil.


James 1:19-20 You must all be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to get angry. Human anger does not produce the righteousness God desires.


Romans 12:19 Never take revenge. Leave that to the righteous anger of God. For the Scriptures say, "I will take revenge; I will pay them back," says the Lord.
