


BLESSINGS



James 1:12 Blessed is the man who endures temptation, because once he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.

1 John 2:1 If anyone does sin, we have an advocate who pleads our case before the Father. He is Jesus Christ, the one who is truly righteous.

Proverbs 18:10 The name of the Lord is a strong tower, the godly run to Him and are safe.

2 Corinthians 5:17 Anyone who belongs to Christ Jesus has become a new person. The old life is gone, a new life has begun!

1 John 4:4 You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

Ephesians 1:4 Even before He made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in His eyes.

Hebrews 4:16 Let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive His mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it most.

Psalms 103:12 As far as the east is from the west, so God has removed our sin from us.

Psalms 107:20 God sent out His Word and healed them, snatching them from the door of death.

Matthew 6:33 Seek first God's kingdom and what God wants. Then all your other needs will be met as well.

Proverbs 3:9–10 Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce. Then He will fill your barns with grain, and your vats will overflow with good wine.

James 4:6-7 The Scriptures say, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble." So humble yourselves before God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Hebrews 6:16-19 Now when people take an oath, they call on someone greater than themselves to hold them to it. And without any question that oath is binding. God also bound Himself with an oath, so that those who received the promise could be perfectly sure that He would never change His mind. So God has given both His promise and His oath. These two things are unchangeable because it is impossible for God to lie. Therefore, we who have fled to Him for refuge can have great confidence as we hold to the hope that lies before us. This hope is a strong and trustworthy anchor for our souls. It leads us through the curtain into God's inner sanctuary.

Psalms 147:3 God heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.

Romans 1:7 You are loved by God and are called to be His own holy people. May God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ give you grace and peace.

Ephesians 2:6 God raised us up with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus.

2 Corinthians 1:3-4 All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. God is our merciful Father and the source of all comfort. He comforts us in all our troubles so that we can comfort others. When they are troubled, we will be able to give them the same comfort God has given us.

Psalms 46:1 God is our refuge and strength, always ready to help in times of trouble.

Matthew 3:11b Jesus will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire.

Acts 11:16 I thought of the Lord's words when He said, "John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit."

Isaiah 59:1–2 Behold, the Lord's hand is not so short that it cannot save; nor is His ear so dull that it cannot hear.

Proverbs 8:18-21 (Wisdom says), "Riches and honor are mine to give. So are wealth and lasting success. What I give is better than the finest gold, better than the purest silver. I do what is right and follow the path of justice. I give wealth to those who love Me, filling their houses with treasures."

Acts 1:8 (Jesus said), "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be My witnesses, telling people about Me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Lamentations 3:21-23 This I recall to mind and therefore I have hope: the faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease. Great is His faithfulness; His mercies are new every morning.

Romans 15:13 I pray that God, the source of hope, will fill you completely with joy and peace because you trust in Him. Then you will overflow with confident hope through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Romans 8:31b If God is for us, who can ever be against us?

Romans 8:28 We know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to His purpose for them.

Psalms 103:1-5 Bless the Lord, O my soul; and all that is within me, bless His holy name! Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget none of His benefits: who forgives all our iniquities, who heals all our diseases, who redeems our life from destruction, who crowns us with lovingkindness and tender mercies, who satisfies our desires with good things, so that our youth is renewed like the eagle's.

Psalms 138:2 I bow before Your holy Temple as I worship. I praise Your name for Your unfailing love and faithfulness; for Your promises are backed by all the honor of Your name.

2 Corinthians 1:20 For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.

Joshua 23:14 Deep in your hearts you know that every promise of the Lord your God has come true. Not a single one has failed!

Psalms 34:17-19 The Lord hears His people when they call to Him for help. He rescues them from all their troubles. The Lord is close to the brokenhearted; He rescues those whose spirits are crushed. The righteous person faces many troubles, but the Lord comes to the rescue each time.

Psalms 5:11-12 But let all those rejoice who put their trust in You; let them ever shout for joy, because You defend them; let those also who love Your name be joyful in You. For You, O Lord, will bless the righteous; with favor You will surround him as a shield.

Psalms 120:1 I took my troubles to the Lord; I cried out to Him, and He answered my prayer.

Psalms 107:20 He sent His Word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.

Psalms 107:31 Let them praise the Lord for His great love and for the wonderful things He has done for them.

Psalms 37:23 The Lord directs the steps of the godly. He delights in every detail of their lives.

Proverbs 15:8 The Lord detests the sacrifice of the wicked, but He delights in the prayers of the upright.

Proverbs 15:22 Plans go wrong for lack of advice; many advisers bring success.

Proverbs 15:24 Wise people's lives get better and better. They avoid whatever would cause their death.

Proverbs 15:30 Good news makes you feel better. Your happiness will show in your eyes.

Psalms 84:11 For the Lord God is a sun and shield; He gives grace and glory. The Lord will withhold no good thing from those who do what is right.

Proverbs 10:22 The blessing of the Lord makes a person rich, and He adds no sorrow with it.

Proverbs 14:31 Whoever mistreats the poor insults their Maker, but whoever is kind to the needy honors God.

2 Corinthians 9:6 Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously.

Proverbs 11:25 The generous will prosper; those who refresh others will themselves be refreshed.

1 Corinthians 2:9 No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love Him.

Psalms 103:17-18 The Lord's love for those who respect Him continues forever and ever, and His goodness continues to their grandchildren and to those who keep His agreement and who remember to obey His orders.

Ephesians 3:20 Now all glory to God, who is able, through His mighty power at work within us, to accomplish infinitely more than we might ask or think.

2 Chronicles 16:9 The eyes of the Lord search the whole earth in order to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to Him.

Jeremiah 29:11-14 "For I know the plans I have for you," says the Lord. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. In those days when you pray, I will listen. If you look for Me wholeheartedly, you will find Me. I will be found by you," says the Lord. "I will end your captivity and restore your fortunes. I will gather you out of the nations where I sent you and will bring you home again to your own land."

Proverbs 16:1-3 We can make our own plans, but the Lord gives the right answer. People may be pure in their own eyes, but the Lord examines their motives. Commit your actions to the Lord, and your plans will succeed.

Galatians 2:20 My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So I live in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

Philippians 4:6–7 Don't be anxious about anything, but pray and give thanks to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your heart and your mind in Christ Jesus.

Deuteronomy 8:18 Remember the Lord your God. He is the one who gives you power to be successful, in order to fulfill the covenant He confirmed to your ancestors with an oath.

Psalms 55:22 Give your burdens to the Lord, and He will take care of you. He will not permit the godly to slip and fall.

Psalms 23:5 You prepare a feast for me in the presence of my enemies. You honor me by anointing my head with oil. My cup overflows with blessings.

John 10:10 The thief comes to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

Genesis 17:2 God says, "I will make My covenant between Me and you and will multiply you exceedingly."

Luke 2:52 Jesus kept increasing in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man.

Genesis 26:12-14 Then Isaac sowed seed in that land and received in the same year a hundred times as much as he had planted, and the Lord favored him with blessings. And Isaac became great and gained more and more until he became very wealthy and distinguished... and the Philistines envied him.

Isaiah 26:3-4 You, Lord, give true peace to those who depend on You, because they trust You. So, trust the Lord always, because He is our Rock forever.

Psalms 29:11 The Lord will give strength to His people; the Lord blesses His people with peace.

Psalms 7:10 God protects me like a shield; He saves those whose hearts are right.

John 14:13-14 (Jesus said), "You can ask for anything in My name, and I will do it, so that the Son can bring glory to the Father. Yes, ask Me for anything in My name, and I will do it!"

Isaiah 54:17 "No weapon formed against you shall prosper, and every tongue which rises against you in judgment You shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord, and their righteousness is from Me," says the Lord.

Isaiah 48:16-17 "Come to me and listen to this. From the beginning I have spoken openly. From the time it began, I was there." Now, the Lord God has sent Me with His Spirit. This is what the Lord, who saves you, the Holy One of Israel, says: "I am the Lord your God, who teaches you to do what is good, who leads you in the way you should go."

Proverbs 22:9 Blessed are those who are generous, because they feed the poor.

Psalms 37:25-26 Once I was young, and now I am old. Yet I have never seen the godly abandoned or their children begging for bread. The godly always give generous loans to others, and their children are a blessing.

Psalms 35:27 May my friends sing and shout for joy. May they always say, "Praise the greatness of the Lord, who loves to see His servants do well."

Deuteronomy 28:1-13 If you fully obey the Lord your God and carefully keep all His commands that I am giving you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the world. You will experience all these blessings if you obey the Lord your God: your towns and your fields will be blessed. Your children and your crops will be blessed. The offspring of your herds and flocks will be blessed. Your fruit baskets and breadboards will be blessed. Wherever you go and whatever you do, you will be blessed. The Lord will conquer your enemies when they attack you.

They will attack you from one direction, but they will scatter from you in seven! The Lord will guarantee a blessing on everything you do and will fill your storehouses with grain. The Lord your God will bless you in the land He is giving you. If you obey the commands of the Lord your God and walk in His ways, the Lord will establish you as His holy people as He swore He would do. Then all the nations of the world will see that you are a people claimed by the Lord, and they will stand in awe of you. The Lord will give you prosperity in the land He swore to your ancestors to give you, blessing you with many children, numerous livestock, and abundant crops. The Lord will send rain at the proper time from His rich treasury in the heavens and will bless all the work you do. You will lend to many nations, but you will never need to borrow from them.

If you listen to these commands of the Lord your God that I am giving you today, and if you carefully obey them, the Lord will make you the head and not the tail, and you will always be on top and never at the bottom.

2 Corinthians 8:9 You know the generous grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. Though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, so that by His poverty He could make you rich.

Numbers 6:24-26 The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the Lord lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.

3 John 1:2 Beloved, I pray that all may go well with you and that you may be in good health, as it goes well with your soul.

Luke 6:38 Give, and you will receive. You will be given much. Pressed down, shaken together, and running over, it will spill into your lap. The way you give to others is the way God will give to you.

Psalms 34:15 The eyes of the Lord watch over those who do right; His ears are open to their cries for help.

Deuteronomy 30:9-10 The Lord your God will make you successful in everything you do. You will have many children, your cattle will have many calves, and your fields will produce good crops, because the Lord will again be happy with you, just as He was with your ancestors. But you must obey the Lord your God by keeping all His commands and rules that are written in this Book of the Teachings. You must return to the Lord your God with your whole being.

Deuteronomy 5:16 Honor your father and mother, as the Lord your God commanded you. Then you will live a long, full life in the land the Lord your God is giving you.

Proverbs 15:33 Respect for the Lord will teach you wisdom. If you want to be honored, you must be humble.

Philippians 4:13 I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

Proverbs 19:17 Being kind to the poor is like lending to the Lord; He will reward you for what you have done.

Deuteronomy 29:9 I will keep the Words of Your covenant, and do them, that I may prosper in all that I do.

Psalms 67:5-6 May the nations praise You, O God. Yes, may all the nations praise You. Then the earth will yield its harvests, and God, our God, will richly bless us.

Malachi 3:10-12 "Bring to the storehouse a full tenth of what you earn so there will be food in My house. Test Me in this," says the Lord All-Powerful. "I will open the windows of heaven for you and pour out all the blessings you need. I will stop the insects so they won't eat your crops. The grapes won't fall from your vines before they are ready to pick," says the Lord All-Powerful. "All the nations will call you blessed, because you will have a pleasant country," says the Lord All-Powerful.
