Psalms 32:7-8 You are my hiding place, You shall preserve me from trouble, You surround me with songs of deliverance. You will instruct me and teach me in the way I should go, You will counsel me with Your eye upon me.

Psalms 33:1-5 I will sing for joy to the Lord, for praise from the upright is beautiful. Give thanks to the Lord with the harp. Sing praises to God with a harp of ten strings. Sing to God a new song; play skillfully with a shout of joy. For the Word of the Lord is right, all Your works, God, are done in faithfulness. You love righteousness and justice, the earth is full of Your goodness.

Psalms 33:8 All the earth shall fear You, let the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of You.

Psalms 33:12 Blessed is the nation whose God is the Lord, the people You have chosen for Your own inheritance.

Psalms 33:18 Behold, Lord, Your eye is on those who fear You, on those who hope for Your lovingkindness.

Psalms 33:19-22 My soul waits for You, You are my help and my shield. For my heart rejoices in You, because I trust in Your holy name. Let Your lovingkindness and mercy be upon me, just as I hope in You.

Psalms 34:1 I will bless You, Lord at all times; Your praise shall continually be in my mouth.

Psalms 34:7-8 The angel of the Lord encamps all around those who fear Him. O taste and see that the Lord is good, blessed is the man who trusts in Him.

Psalms 50:23 Giving thanks is a sacrifice that truly honors Me. If you keep to My path, I will reveal to you the salvation of God.

Isaiah 61:1 The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me, because the Lord has anointed me to preach good tidings to the poor; You have sent me to heal the broken hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to those who are bound.

Psalms 62:5-8 My soul, wait in silence for God only, for my hope is from You. You only are my rock and my salvation, my stronghold; I will not be shaken. On You, God my salvation and my glory rest, the rock of my strength my refuge is in You. I will trust in You at all times.

Psalms 63:1-5 O God, You are my God; I earnestly search for You. My soul thirsts for You; my whole body longs for You in this parched and weary land where there is no water. I have seen You in Your sanctuary and gazed upon Your power and glory. Your unfailing love is better than life itself; how I praise You! I will praise You as long as I live, lifting up my hands to You in prayer. You satisfy me more than the richest feast. I will praise You with songs of joy.

Psalms 84:10-11 A day in Your courts is better than a thousand anywhere else. I would rather stand at the threshold of Your house, God, than dwell in the tents of wickedness. For You are a sun and shield; You give grace and glory; no good thing do You withhold from those who walk uprightly.

Psalms 89:8 O Lord of hosts, who is mighty like You? Your faithfulness also surrounds You.

Psalms 89:11 The heavens are Yours, the earth is also Yours, the world and all it contains, You have founded them.

Psalms 89:13-18 You have a mighty arm, strong is Your hand and high is Your right hand. Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne, lovingkindness and truth go before You. Blessed am I who knows the joyful sound! I walk, O Lord, in the light of Your countenance. In Your name, I rejoice all day long and by Your righteousness I am exalted. For You are the glory of my strength, and by Your favor my horn (my strength) is exalted. For my shield belongs to the Lord.

Psalms 145:1-21 Every day I will bless You, and I will praise Your name forever and ever. Great are You, Lord, and highly to be praised; Your greatness is unsearchable. One generation shall praise Your works to another and shall declare Your mighty acts.

I will meditate on the glorious splendor of Your majesty and on Your wondrous works. Men shall speak of the power of Your awesome acts, and I will declare Your greatness. They shall eagerly utter the memory of Your abundant goodness and shall shout joyfully of Your righteousness.

You are gracious and full of compassion, slow to anger and great in lovingkindness. You are good to all, and Your tender mercies are over all Your works. All Your works shall praise You, O Lord, and Your godly saints shall bless You. I will speak of the glory of Your kingdom and talk of Your power; to make known to the sons of men Your mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of Your kingdom.

Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and Your dominion endures throughout all generations. You sustain all who fall and raise up all who are bowed down. The eyes of all look expectantly to You, and You give us all our food in due time. You open Your hand and satisfy the desire of every living thing. You are righteous in all Your ways, gracious in all Your works.

Psalms 139:1-8 O Lord, You have searched me and known me. You know when I sit down and when I rise up; You understand my thought from afar. You comprehend my path and my lying down, You are intimately acquainted with all my ways. Even before there was a word on my tongue, behold, O Lord, You know it all. You have enclosed me behind and before and laid Your hand upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful to me. It is too high; I cannot attain it. Where can I go from Your Spirit? Where can I run from Your presence? If I ascend to heaven, You are there; if I make my bed in the depths, You are there.

Psalms 139:13 You formed my inward parts, You wove me in my mother's womb. I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Marvelous are Your works and my soul knows it very well.

Psalms 139:17 How precious are Your thoughts to me O God, how great is the sum of them! If I should count them, they would outnumber the sand. When I awake, I am still with You.

Psalms 139:23-24 Search me O God, and know my heart, try me and know my anxious thoughts, and see if there is any wicked way in me, and lead me in the everlasting way.

Psalms 147:1 Praise the Lord! For it is good to sing praises to our God; for it is pleasant and praise is beautiful.

Psalms 147:3 God, You heal the broken-hearted and bind up their wounds.

Psalms 147:11 You favor those who fear You, those who wait for Your lovingkindness.

Psalms 149:4 You take pleasure in Your people; You will beautify the afflicted ones with salvation.

Psalms 149:3-6 Praise His name with dancing, accompanied by tambourine and harp. For the Lord delights in His people; He crowns the humble with victory. Let the faithful rejoice that He honors them. Let them sing for joy as they lie on their beds. Let the praises of God be in their mouths, and a sharp sword in their hands.

Psalms 141:2-3 May my prayer be counted as incense before You, the lifting of my hands as the evening offering. Set a guard, O Lord, over my mouth; keep watch over the door of my lips.

Proverbs 12:14 I will be satisfied with good by the fruit of my words, and the deeds of my hands will return to me.

Proverbs 18:20-21 With the fruit of my mouth, my stomach will be satisfied; I will be satisfied with the product of my lips. Death and life are in the power of the tongue and those who love it will eat its fruit.

Proverbs 16:21 The wise in heart will be discerning and sweetness of speech increases persuasiveness.

Proverbs 16:23-24 The heart of the wise teaches my mouth and adds persuasiveness to my lips. Pleasant words are a honeycomb, sweet to the soul and healing to the bones.

1 Corinthians 2:9 No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love Him.

1 Peter 2:9 You are a chosen people. You are royal priests, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for He called you out of the darkness into His wonderful light.

Romans 8:28 We know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to His purpose for them.

Psalms 61:10 I will greatly rejoice in the Lord, my soul shall be joyful in You, God; for You have clothed me with the garments of salvation, You have covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorns herself with jewels.

Psalms 35:9 My soul shall rejoice in the Lord, I will rejoice in Your salvation.
