John 15:7 (Jesus said), "If you abide in Me and My Words abide in you, you may ask for anything you want, and it will be done for you."


OBEDIENCE

Proverbs 22:1 A good name is to be more desired than great riches. Favor is better than silver and gold.


Proverbs 22:4 True humility and fear of the Lord lead to riches, honor, and long life.


1 John 5:18 We know that God's children do not make a practice of sinning, for God's Son holds us securely, and the evil one cannot touch us.

Philemon 1:6 I am praying that you will put into action the generosity that comes from your faith as you understand and experience all the good things we have in Christ.



Psalms 46:1 God is our refuge and strength, always ready to help in times of trouble.


Matthew 3:11b Jesus will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire.




1 John 4:4 Greater is He who is in me than he who is in the world.



They will hold you up with their hands so you won't even hurt your foot on a stone. You will trample upon lions and cobras; you will crush fierce lions and serpents under your feet!

The Lord says, “I will rescue those who love Me. I will protect those who trust in My name. When they call on Me, I will answer; I will be with them in trouble. I will rescue and honor them. I will reward them with a long life and give them My salvation.”

Psalms 86:11-13 Teach me Your way, O Lord; I will walk in Your truth; Give me a singleness of heart to fear Your name.
