FAITH






You won't be afraid of sudden trouble; you won't fear the ruin that comes to the wicked, because the Lord will keep you safe. He will keep you from being trapped.

Romans 6:6 We know that our old self was crucified with Him so that our body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin.




Matthew 6:15 If you do not forgive others, your Father in heaven will not forgive your sins.

Psalms 56:3-4 When I am afraid, I will trust you. I praise God for His Word. I trust God, so I am not afraid. What can human beings do to me?


Psalms 91:10 No evil shall come on me, nor shall any plague or calamity come near me.

BLESSINGS



Psalms 120:1 I took my troubles to the Lord; I cried out to Him, and He answered my prayer.




Psalms 107:20 He sent His Word and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.


Psalms 34:1 I will bless You, Lord at all times; Your praise shall continually be in my mouth.


Proverbs 12:14 I will be satisfied with good by the fruit of my words, and the deeds of my hands will return to me.

1 Timothy 1:12 I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has strengthened me because He considered me faithful, putting me into service.


Hebrews 6:13-20 Our great desire is that you will keep on loving others as long as life lasts, in order to make certain that what you hope for will come true. Then you will not become spiritually dull and indifferent. Instead, you will follow the example of those who are going to inherit God's promises because of their faith and endurance. For example, there was God's promise to Abraham. Since there was no one greater to swear by, God took an oath in His own name, saying: "I will certainly bless you, and I will multiply your descendants beyond number." Then Abraham waited patiently, and he received what God had promised. Now when people take an oath, they call on someone greater than themselves to hold them to it. And without any question that oath is binding. God also bound Himself with an oath, so that those who received the promise could be perfectly sure that He would never change His mind.



So God has given both His promise and His oath. These two things are unchangeable because it is impossible for God to lie. Therefore, we who have fled to Him for refuge can have great confidence as we hold to the hope that lies before us. This hope is a strong and trustworthy anchor for our souls.

Psalms 119:105 Your Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light to my path.

Psalms 119:11 Your Word have I hidden in my heart, that I may not sin against you.


