SALVATION

John 10:27-28 (Jesus said), “My sheep hear My voice, and I know them and they follow Me. And I give them eternal life and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch them out of My hand.”

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, God is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from unrighteousness.

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Luke 1:46-47 My soul exalts the Lord and my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior.

FAITH

2 Corinthians 3:17 The Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.

Romans 15:13 I pray that God, the source of hope, will fill you completely with joy and peace because you trust Him. Then you will overflow with confident hope through the power of the Holy Spirit.

2 Corinthians 1:20 For all of God's promises are "Yes and Amen" through Christ Jesus, for God's glory.

OBEDIENCE

Proverbs 15:1-2 A gentle answer turns away anger, but a harsh word stirs up anger. The tongue of the wise uses knowledge rightly, but the mouth of fools pours forth foolishness.

Proverbs 15:7 The lips of the wise spread knowledge, but the hearts of fools are not so.

Proverbs 15:23 A man has joy in a fitting answer, and how delightful is a timely word.

Proverbs 15:28 The heart of the righteous studies how to answer, but the mouth of the wicked pours out evil things.

Proverbs 17:1 Better is a dry piece of toast and quietness with it than a house full of feasting with strife.

Proverbs 17:9-10 Whoever forgives someone's sin makes a friend, but gossiping about the sin breaks up friendships. A wise person will learn more from a warning than a fool will learn from a hundred lashings.

Proverbs 19:1 It is better to be poor and honest than to be foolish and tell lies.

1 Corinthians 13:4-7 Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous or boastful or proud or rude. It does not demand its own way. It is not irritable, and it keeps no record of being wronged.

It does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out. Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance.

1 Corinthians 13:9-13 Now our knowledge is partial and incomplete, and even the gift of prophecy reveals only part of the whole picture! But when the time of perfection comes, these partial things will become useless. When I was a child, I spoke and thought and reasoned as a child. But when I grew up, I put away childish things. Now we see things imperfectly, like puzzling reflections in a mirror, but then we will see everything with perfect clarity. All that I know now is partial and incomplete, but then I will know everything completely, just as God now knows me completely. Three things will last forever—faith, hope, and love—and the greatest of these is love.

FREEDOM

Romans 12:1-2 So brothers and sisters, since God has shown us great mercy, I beg you to offer your lives as a living sacrifice to Him. Your offering must be only for God and pleasing to Him, which is the spiritual way for you to worship. Do not be shaped by this world; instead be changed within by a new way of thinking. Then you will be able to decide what God wants for you; you will know what is good and pleasing to Him and what is perfect.

Romans 12:19 Never take revenge. Leave that to the righteous anger of God. For the Scriptures say, "I will take revenge; I will pay them back," says the Lord.

Luke 10:27 You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your strength, and all your mind. And, love your neighbor as yourself.

1 Kings 8:56 Praise be to the Lord who has given rest to His people, just as He promised. Not one Word has failed of all the good promises He gave through His servant Moses.


Psalms 118:17 I will not die; instead, I will live to tell what the Lord has done.

Psalms 119:93, 114 I will never forget Your commandments, for by them You give me life. You are my refuge and my shield; Your Word is my source of hope.

Psalms 130:5-7 I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, and in His Word I do hope. My soul waits for the Lord, more than those who watch for the morning. Yes, more than those who watch for the morning. I hope in the Lord, for with the Lord there is mercy, and with Him is abundant redemption.

John 14:12-14 (Jesus said) “I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in Me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father. You can ask for anything in My name, and I will do it, so that the Son can bring glory to the Father. Yes, ask Me for anything in My name, and I will do it!”

Psalms 119:49-50, 74b God, remember Your promise to me; it is my only hope. Your promise revives me; it comforts me in all my troubles. May all who fear You find in me a cause for joy, for I have put my hope in Your Word.



Psalms 103:1-5 Bless the Lord, O my soul; and all that is within me, I will bless His Holy name. Bless the Lord, O my soul; I will not forget any of Your benefits. You forgive all my sins, You heal all my diseases. You redeem my life from destruction, You crown me with lovingkindness and compassion, and You satisfy my desires with good things so that my youth is renewed like the eagle.

Proverbs 3:7-8 I will not be wise in my own eyes, but will fear You, Lord, and turn away from evil. It will be health to my body and strength to my bones.

Psalms 34:15 The eyes of the Lord watch over those who do right; His ears are open to their cries for help.

Hebrews 10:23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.

Proverbs 17:22 A cheerful heart is good medicine, but a broken spirit saps a person's strength.

Hebrews 10:35-36 So do not throw away this confident trust in the Lord. Remember the great reward it brings us! Patient endurance is what we need now, so that we will continue to do God's will. Then we will receive all that He has promised.

This is what the Lord, who saves you, the Holy One of Israel, says: “I am the Lord your God, who teaches you to do what is good, who leads you in the way you should go.”

Proverbs 22:9 Blessed are those who are generous, because they feed the poor.

Psalms 37:25-26 Once I was young, and now I am old. Yet I have never seen the godly abandoned or their children begging for bread. The godly always give generous loans to others, and their children are a blessing.

Psalms 35:27 May my friends sing and shout for joy. May they always say, "Praise the greatness of the Lord, who loves to see His servants do well."

Deuteronomy 28:1-13 If you fully obey the Lord your God and carefully keep all His commands that I am giving you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the world. You will experience all these blessings if you obey the Lord your God: your towns and your fields will be blessed. Your children and your crops will be blessed. The offspring of your herds and flocks will be blessed. Your fruit baskets and breadboards will be blessed. Wherever you go and whatever you do, you will be blessed. The Lord will conquer your enemies when they attack you. They will attack you from one direction, but they will scatter from you in seven! The Lord will guarantee a blessing on everything you do and will fill your storehouses with grain. The Lord your God will bless you in the land He is giving you.

If you obey the commands of the Lord your God and walk in His ways, the Lord will establish you as His holy people as He swore He would do. Then all the nations of the world will see that you are a people claimed by the Lord, and they will stand in awe of you. The Lord will give you prosperity in the land He swore to your ancestors to give you, blessing you with many children, numerous livestock, and abundant crops. The Lord will send rain at the proper time from His rich treasury in the heavens and will bless all the work you do. You will lend to many nations, but you will never need to borrow from them. If you listen to these commands of the Lord your God that I am giving you today, and if you carefully obey them, the Lord will make you the head and not the tail, and you will always be on top and never at the bottom.

2 Corinthians 8:9 You know the generous grace of our Lord Jesus Christ. Though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, so that by His poverty He could make you rich.

Numbers 6:24-26 The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make His face to shine upon you and be gracious to you; the Lord lift up His countenance upon you and give you peace.

3 John 1:2 Beloved, I pray that all may go well with you and that you may be in good health, as it goes well with your soul.

Luke 6:38 Give, and you will receive. You will be given much. Pressed down, shaken together, and running over, it will spill into your lap. The way you give to others is the way God will give to you.

Psalms 34:15 The eyes of the Lord watch over those who do right; His ears are open to their cries for help.

Deuteronomy 30:9-10 The Lord your God will make you successful in everything you do. You will have many children, your cattle will have many calves, and your fields will produce good crops, because the Lord will again be happy with you, just as He was with your ancestors.

Proverbs 12:14 I will be satisfied with good by the fruit of my words, and the deeds of my hands will return to me.

Proverbs 18:20-21 With the fruit of my mouth, my stomach will be satisfied; I will be satisfied with the product of my lips. Death and life are in the power of the tongue and those who love it will eat its fruit.

Proverbs 16:21 The wise in heart will be discerning and sweetness of speech increases persuasiveness.

Proverbs 16:23-24 The heart of the wise teaches my mouth and adds persuasiveness to my lips. Pleasant words are a honeycomb, sweet to the soul and healing to the bones.

1 Corinthians 2:9 No eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no mind has imagined what God has prepared for those who love Him.

1 Peter 2:9 You are a chosen people. You are royal priests, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for He called you out of the darkness into His wonderful light.

Romans 8:28 We know that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to His purpose for them.

Malachi 4:2 The Lord of Heaven's Armies says, "The day of judgment is coming, burning like a furnace. On that day the arrogant and the wicked will be burned up like straw. They will be consumed—roots, branches, and all. But for you who fear My name, the Sun of Righteousness will rise with healing in His wings. And you will go free, leaping with joy like calves let out to pasture. On the day when I act, you will tread upon the wicked as if they were dust under your feet," says the Lord of Heaven's Armies.

PROMISES


Deuteronomy 30:15-20 (God says), “Today I am giving you a choice between life and death, between prosperity and disaster. For I command you this day to love the Lord your God and to keep His commands, decrees, and regulations by walking in His ways. If you do this, you will live and multiply, and the Lord your God will bless you and the land you are about to enter and occupy. But if your heart turns away and you refuse to listen, and if you are drawn away to serve and worship other gods, then I warn you now that you will certainly be destroyed. You will not live a long, good life in the land you are crossing the Jordan to occupy. Today I have given you the choice between life and death, between blessings and curses.

Now I call on heaven and earth to witness the choice you make. Oh, that you would choose life, so that you and your descendants might live! You can make this choice by loving the Lord your God, obeying Him, and committing yourself firmly to Him. This is the key to your life. And if you love and obey the Lord, you will live long in the land the Lord swore to give your ancestors Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.”

Deuteronomy 8:18 Remember the Lord your God. He is the one who gives you power to be successful, in order to fulfill the covenant He confirmed to your ancestors with an oath.


Malachi 3:10 “Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so there will be enough food in my Temple. If you do,” says the Lord of Heaven’s Armies, “I will open the windows of heaven for you. I will pour out a blessing so great you won’t have enough room to take it in! Try it! Put me to the test!”

John 15:5-8 (Jesus said), “I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in Me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from Me you can do nothing. Anyone who does not remain in Me is thrown away like a useless branch and withers. Such branches are gathered into a pile to be burned.
