

SALVATION

Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, and today and forever.

Matthew 7:13-14 You can enter God's Kingdom only through the narrow gate. The highway to hell is broad, and its gate is wide for the many who choose that way. But the gateway to life is very narrow and the road is difficult, and only a few ever find it.

Revelation 3:19 Those whom I love, I correct and discipline; be zealous therefore and repent.

1 Corinthians 6:11 We are made right with God by calling on the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God.

Romans 10:13 Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.

1 John 2:1 We have an advocate, Jesus Christ, who intercedes for us before the Father.

John 14:1-6 (Jesus said), "Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also. And where I go you know, and the way you know." Thomas said to Him, "Lord, we do not know where You are going, and how can



we know the way?" Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

FAITH

Psalms 118:24 This is the day the Lord has made. We will rejoice and be glad in it!

Matthew 21:22 Whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive.

Romans 4:18-25 Even when there was no reason for hope, Abraham kept hoping—believing that he would become the father of many nations. For God had said to him, "That's how many descendants you will have!" And Abraham's faith did not weaken, even though, at about 100 years of age, he figured his body was as good as dead—and so was Sarah's womb. Abraham never wavered in believing God's promise. In fact, his faith grew stronger, and in this he brought glory to God. He was fully convinced that God is able to do whatever He promises. And because of Abraham's faith, God counted him as righteous. And when God counted him as righteous, it wasn't just for Abraham's benefit. It was recorded for our benefit, too, assuring us that God will also count us as righteous if we believe in Him, the one who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead. He was handed over to die because of our sins, and He was raised to life to make us right with God.



OBEDIENCE

John 14:15-17 (Jesus said), "If you love Me, you will obey My commands. I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper to be with you forever - the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept Him, because it does not see Him or know Him. But you know Him, because He lives with you and He will be in you."

Proverbs 19:11 A man's discretion makes him slow to anger, and it is his glory to overlook a sin.

Proverbs 19:20-21 Listen to advice and accept correction, and in the end you will be wise. People can make all kinds of plans, but only the Lord's plan will happen.

John 8:31-32 So Jesus said to the Jews who believed in Him, "If you continue to obey My teaching, you are truly My followers. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free."

Proverbs 28:13 If you hide your sins, you will not succeed. If you confess and reject them, you will receive mercy.

Proverbs 19:16 Keep the commandments and keep your life; despising them leads to death.

Then his body will become as healthy as a child's, firm and youthful again.



Hebrews 12:10-14a For our earthly fathers disciplined us for a few years, doing the best they knew how. But God's discipline is always good for us, so that we might share in His holiness. No discipline is enjoyable while it is happening—it's painful! But afterward there will be a peaceful harvest of right living for those who are trained in this way. So take a new grip with your tired hands and strengthen your weak knees. Mark out a straight path for your feet so that those who are weak and lame will not fall but become strong. Work at living in peace with everyone, and work at living a holy life.

John 11:25-26 Jesus said, "I am the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in Me will have life even if they die. And everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die."

Psalms 19:14 Let the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O God, my strength and redeemer.

Psalms 18:1-2 I love You, Lord; You are my strength. The Lord is my rock, my fortress, and my savior; my God is my rock, in whom I find protection. He is my shield, the power that saves me, and my place of safety.

Job 22:20-30 Submit to God, and you will have peace; then things will go well for you. Listen to His instructions, and store them in your heart. If you return to the Almighty, you will be restored—so clean up your life. If you give up your lust for money and throw your precious gold into the river, the Almighty Himself will be your treasure. He will be your precious silver! Then you will take delight in the Almighty and look up to God. You will pray to Him, and He will hear you, and you will fulfill your vows to Him. PROMISES

Luke 9:1 One day Jesus called together His twelve disciples and gave them power and authority to cast out all demons and to heal all diseases.

Jeremiah 17:7-8 Blessed are those who trust in the Lord and have made the Lord their hope and confidence. They are like trees planted along a riverbank, with roots that reach deep into the water.
