HEALING

Isaiah 55:11 God says, “So shall My Word be that goes forth out of My mouth. It shall not return to Me void, but it shall accomplish what I please and will certainly do what I sent it to do.”

Psalms 91:4b Your faithful promises are my armor and protection.

Exodus 15:26 (God) said, “If you will listen carefully to the voice of the Lord your God and do what is right in His sight, obeying His commands and keeping all His decrees, then I will not make you suffer any of the diseases I sent on the Egyptians; for I am the Lord who heals you.”

Exodus 23:25 (God said) “You must serve only the Lord your God. If you do, I will bless you with food and water, and I will protect you from illness. There will be no miscarriages or infertility in your land, and I will give you long, full lives.”

Deuteronomy 7:15 The Lord will protect us from all sickness. He will not let us suffer from the terrible diseases the Israelites knew in Egypt, but He will inflict them on all our enemies!

1 John 5:14-15 And this is the boldness we have in God’s presence: that if we ask God for anything that agrees with what He wants, He hears us. If we know He hears us every time we ask Him, we know we have what we ask from Him.

1 John 3:21-22 Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence toward God. And whatever we ask we receive from Him, because we keep His commandments and do those things that are pleasing in His sight.

Matthew 16:19-20 (Jesus said) “I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.”

Matthew 18:19 If two of us agree here on earth concerning anything we ask, My Father in heaven will do it for us.

Joshua 23:14 I know with all my heart and soul that not one of all of the good promises the Lord my God gave me has failed. Every promise has been fulfilled; and not one has failed.

Deuteronomy 31:6, 8 “Be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid and do not panic before them. For the Lord your God will personally go ahead of you. He will neither fail you nor abandon you. Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the Lord will personally go ahead of you. He will be with you; He will neither fail you nor abandon you.”

Matthew 19:26 Jesus looked and said to them, “With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible.”

Mark 9:23-24 What do you mean, ‘If I can?’ Jesus asked. “Anything is possible if a person believes.” The father instantly cried out, “I do believe, but help me overcome my unbelief!”

1 John 5:18 We know that God’s children do not make a practice of sinning, for God’s Son holds us securely, and the evil one cannot touch us.

John 16:23b-24 I tell you the truth, you will ask the Father directly, and He will grant your request because you use My name. You haven’t done this before. Ask, using My name, and you will receive, and you will have abundant joy.

Mark 11:23-25 Jesus answered, “Have faith in God. I tell you the truth, you can say to this mountain, ‘Go, fall into the sea.’ And if you have no doubts in your mind and believe that what you say will happen, God will do it for you. So I tell you to believe that you have received the things you ask for in prayer, and God will give them to you.”

1 Peter 2:24 Christ carried our sins in His body on the cross so we would stop living for sin and start living for what is right. And we are healed because of His wounds.

Romans 10:17 Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God.

John 15:16-17 (Jesus said), “You did not choose Me; I chose you. And I gave you this work: to go and produce fruit, fruit that will last. Then the Father will give you anything you ask for in My name. This is My command: Love each other.”

Philemon 1:6 I am praying that you will put into action the generosity that comes from your faith as you understand and experience all the good things we have in Christ.

Psalms 107:19-22 “Lord, help!” we cry in our trouble, and He saved us from our distress. He sent out His Word and healed us, snatching us from the door of death. Let us praise the Lord for His great love and for the wonderful things He has done for us. Let us offer sacrifices of thanksgiving and sing joyfully about His glorious acts.

Psalms 145:13 For Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom. You rule throughout all generations. The Lord always keeps His promises; He is gracious in all He does.

James 1:6-8, 13-16 When you ask God, you must believe and not doubt. Anyone who doubts is like a wave in the sea, blown up and down by the wind. Such doubters are thinking two different things at the same time, and they cannot decide about anything they do. They should not think they will receive anything from the Lord. When people are tempted, they should not say, "God is tempting me." Evil cannot tempt God, and God Himself does not tempt anyone. But people are tempted when their own evil desire leads them away and traps them. This desire leads to sin, and then the sin grows and brings death. My dear brothers and sisters, do not be fooled about this.

Ephesians 3:20-21 Now all glory to God, who is able, through His mighty power at work within us, to accomplish infinitely more than we might ask or think. Glory to Him in the church and in Christ Jesus through all generations forever and ever! Amen.

Hebrews 11:1 Faith shows the reality of what we hope for; it is the evidence of things we cannot see.

Hebrews 11:6 Without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that God is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

Psalms 31:14-15 I trust in you, O Lord; I say, you are my God. My times are in your hands.

Isaiah 12:2 God has come to save me. I will trust in Him and not be afraid. The Lord God is my strength and my song; He has given me victory.

Isaiah 53:4-5 Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.

Jeremiah 1:12 Then the Lord said to me, “You have seen well, for I am watching over *My Word* to perform it.”

Jeremiah 30:17 You will restore me to health and heal my wounds.

Matthew 21:21-22 Jesus told them, “I tell you the truth, if you have faith and don’t doubt, you can do things like this and much more. You can even say to this mountain, ‘May you be lifted up and thrown into the sea,’ and it will happen. You can pray for anything, and if you have faith, you will receive it.”

Mark 10:52 And Jesus said to him, “Go, for your faith has healed you.” Instantly the man could see, and he followed Jesus down the road.

Acts 3:16 It was faith in Jesus that made this crippled man well. You can see this man, and you know him. He was made completely well because of trust in Jesus, and you all saw it happen!

2 Corinthians 1:20 For all of the promises of God in Jesus are “Yes” and in Him “Amen,” to the glory of God.

2 Thessalonians 3:3 The Lord is faithful and will give you strength and will protect you from the evil one.

Psalms 30:2 O Lord my God, I cried to You for help, and You restored my health.

Psalms 73:26 My health may fail, and my spirit may grow weak, but God remains the strength of my heart; He is mine forever.

Proverbs 14:30 A peaceful heart leads to a healthy body; jealousy is like cancer in the bones.

Proverbs 17:22 A happy heart is a good medicine and a cheerful mind works healing, but a broken spirit dries up the bones.

Proverbs 18:21 The tongue can bring death or life; those who love to talk will reap the consequences.

Isaiah 32:3 The eyes of those who see will not be dim, and the ears of those who hear will listen.

Isaiah 40:29 He gives power to the weak and strength to the powerless.

Mark 16:15-18 (Jesus) told them, “Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone. Anyone who believes and is baptized will be saved. But anyone who refuses to believe will be condemned. These miraculous signs will accompany those who believe: they will cast out demons in My name, and they will speak in new languages. They will be able to handle snakes with safety, and if they drink anything poisonous, it won’t hurt them. They will be able to place their hands on the sick, and they will be healed.”

Isaiah 58:8 Your light will shine like the dawn, and your wounds will quickly heal. Your God will walk before you, and the glory of the Lord will protect you from behind.

Jeremiah 17:14 Heal me, O Lord, and I shall be healed; save me and I shall be saved, for You are my praise.

Acts 10:38 You know about Jesus from Nazareth, that God gave Him the Holy Spirit and power. You know how Jesus went everywhere doing good and healing those who were ruled by the devil, because God was with Him.

James 5:13-16 Anyone who is having troubles should pray. Anyone who is happy should sing praises. Anyone who is sick should call the church's elders. They should pray for and pour oil on the person in the name of the Lord. And the prayer that is said with faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will heal that person. And if the person has sinned, the sins will be forgiven. Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so God can heal you. When a believing person prays, great things happen.

1 Kings 8:56 Praise be to the Lord who has given rest to His people, just as He promised. Not one Word has failed of all the good promises He gave through His servant Moses.

Psalms 118:17 I will not die; instead, I will live to tell what the Lord has done.

Psalms 119:93, 114 I will never forget Your commandments, for by them You give me life. You are my refuge and my shield; Your Word is my source of hope.

Psalms 130:5-7 I wait for the Lord, my soul waits, and in His Word I do hope. My soul waits for the Lord, more than those who watch for the morning. Yes, more than those who watch for the morning. I hope in the Lord, for with the Lord there is mercy, and with Him is abundant redemption.

John 14:12-14 (Jesus said) “I tell you the truth, anyone who believes in Me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works, because I am going to be with the Father. You can ask for anything in My name, and I will do it, so that the Son can bring glory to the Father. Yes, ask Me for anything in My name, and I will do it!”

Psalms 119:49-50, 74b God, remember Your promise to me; it is my only hope. Your promise revives me; it comforts me in all my troubles. May all who fear You find in me a cause for joy, for I have put my hope in Your Word.

Psalms 103:1-5 Bless the Lord, O my soul; and all that is within me, I will bless His Holy name. Bless the Lord, O my soul; I will not forget any of Your benefits, God. You forgive all my sins, You heal all my diseases. You redeem my life from destruction, You crown me with lovingkindness and compassion, and You satisfy my desires with good things so that my youth is renewed like the eagle.

Proverbs 3:7-8 I will not be wise in my own eyes, but will fear You, Lord, and turn away from evil. It will be health to my body and strength to my bones.

Psalms 34:15 The eyes of the Lord watch over those who do right; His ears are open to their cries for help.

Hebrews 10:23 Let us hold fast the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is faithful.

Proverbs 17:22 A cheerful heart is good medicine, but a broken spirit saps a person's strength.

Hebrews 10:35-36 So do not throw away this confident trust in the Lord. Remember the great reward it brings us! Patient endurance is what we need now, so that we will continue to do God's will. Then we will receive all that He has promised.

Job 33:22-25 They are at death's door; the angels of death wait for them. But if an angel from heaven appears—a special messenger to intercede for a person and declare that he is upright—he will be gracious and say, “Rescue him from the grave, for I have found a ransom for his life.” Then his body will become as healthy as a child's, firm and youthful again.

Hebrews 12:10-14a For our earthly fathers disciplined us for a few years, doing the best they knew how. But God's discipline is always good for us, so that we might share in His holiness. No discipline is enjoyable while it is happening—it's painful! But afterward there will be a peaceful harvest of right living for those who are trained in this way. So take a new grip with your tired hands and strengthen your weak knees.

Mark out a straight path for your feet so that those who are weak and lame will not fall but become strong. Work at living in peace with everyone, and work at living a holy life.

John 11:25-26 Jesus said, "I am the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in Me will have life even if they die. And everyone who lives and believes in Me will never die."

Psalms 19:14 Let the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart be acceptable in Your sight, O God, my strength and redeemer.

Psalms 18:1-2 I love You, Lord; You are my strength. The Lord is my rock, my fortress, and my savior; my God is my rock, in whom I find protection. He is my shield, the power that saves me, and my place of safety.

Job 22:20-30 Submit to God, and you will have peace; then things will go well for you. Listen to His instructions, and store them in your heart. If you return to the Almighty, you will be restored—so clean up your life. If you give up your lust for money and throw your precious gold into the river, the Almighty Himself will be your treasure. He will be your precious silver! Then you will take delight in the Almighty and look up to God. You will pray to Him, and He will hear you, and you will fulfill your vows to Him.

You will succeed in whatever you choose to do, and light will shine on the road ahead of you. If people are in trouble and you say, “Help them,” God will save them. Even sinners will be rescued; they will be rescued because your hands are pure.

Proverbs 12:18 Some people make cutting remarks, but the words of the wise bring healing.

Matthew 12:35 A good person produces good things from the treasury of a good heart, and an evil person produces evil things from the treasury of an evil heart.

Romans 15:13 I pray that the God who gives hope will fill you with much joy and peace while you trust in Him. Then your hope will overflow by the power of the Holy Spirit.
