God's promises are an offer to us with a GUARANTEED result. The Premise to receive our Promise is to pursue God, obey Him and wait for Him to strongly support us – in every circumstance.



Joshua 21:45 Not a single one of all the good promises the Lord had given to the family of Israel was left unfulfilled; everything He had spoken came true.

2 Corinthians 15:57 Thanks be to God, who gives us victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

John 14:6 Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to Father God, except through Me."

John 14:3 (Jesus said) "I go and prepare a place for you, and I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also."

Hebrews 4:16 Let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive His mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it most.

Proverbs 3:7-8 Don't be impressed with your own wisdom. Instead, fear the Lord and turn away from evil. Then you will have healing for your body and strength for your bones.

Psalms 5:11-12 But let all who take refuge in You rejoice; let them sing joyful praises forever. Spread Your protection over them, that all who love Your name may be filled with joy. For You bless the godly, O Lord; You surround them with Your shield of love.

Deuteronomy 31:8 Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the Lord will personally go ahead of you. He will be with you; He will neither fail you nor abandon you.

Numbers 23:19-20 God is not a man, so He does not lie. He is not human, so He does not change His mind. Has He ever spoken and failed to act? Has He ever promised and not carried it through? Listen, I received a command to bless; God has blessed, and I cannot reverse it!

2 Corinthians 1:20-22 For all of God's promises have been fulfilled in Christ with a resounding "Yes!" And through Christ, our "Amen" ascends to God for His glory. It is God who enables us, along with you, to stand firm for Christ.

He has commissioned us, and He has identified us as His own by placing the Holy Spirit in our hearts as the first installment that guarantees everything He has promised us.

Philippians 2:10-11 At the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Matthew 21:22 You can pray for anything, and if you have faith, you will receive it.

Psalms 103:11-13 As high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is Your lovingkindness toward me, because I honor and respect You. As far as the east is from the west, so far have You removed my transgressions from me. Just as a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear Him.

2 Corinthians 4:8-10 I am hard pressed on every side, yet I am not crushed, perplexed but not in despair, persecuted but not forsaken, struck down but not destroyed. I carry Jesus' death in my body so that the life of Jesus can be seen in me.

Galatians 2:20 I have been crucified with Christ, it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. And the life which I now live in the flesh, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loves me and gave Himself for me.

1 John 4:4 Greater is He who is in me than he who is in the world.

Psalms 90:17 The favor of the Lord my God is upon me; You will establish the work of my hands.

Psalms 40:1-4a I waited patiently for You, Lord, and You inclined to me and heard my cry. You brought me out of the pit of destruction, out of the miry clay. And You set my feet upon a rock, making my footsteps firm. You put a new song in my mouth, a song of praise to You. Many will see and fear and will trust in You. How blessed is the man who has made You his trust.

Psalms 91:1-16 Those who live in the shelter of the Most High will find rest in the shadow of the Almighty. This I declare about the Lord: He alone is my refuge, my place of safety; He is my God, and I trust Him. For He will rescue you from every trap and protect you from deadly disease. He will cover you with His feathers. He will shelter you with His wings.

His faithful promises are your armor and protection. Do not be afraid of the terrors of the night, nor the arrows that fly in the day. Do not dread the disease that stalks in darkness, nor the disaster that strikes at midday. Though a thousand fall at your side, though ten thousand are dying around you, these evils will not touch you. Just open your eyes, and see how the wicked are punished. If you make the Lord your refuge, if you make the Most High your shelter, no evil will conquer you; no plague will come near your home. For He will order His angels to protect you wherever you go. They will hold you up with their hands so you won't even hurt your foot on a stone. You will trample upon lions and cobras; you will crush fierce lions and serpents under your feet! The Lord says, "I will rescue those who love Me. I will protect those who trust in My name.

When they call on Me, I will answer; I will be with them in trouble. I will rescue and honor them. I will reward them with a long life and give them My salvation."

Psalms 86:9-10 All nations whom You have made shall come and worship before You, O Lord, and shall glorify Your name. For You are great, and do wondrous things, You alone are God.

Psalms 86:11-13 Teach me Your way, O Lord; I will walk in Your truth; Give me a singleness of heart to fear Your name. I will praise You, my God, with all my heart, and I will glorify Your name forever. For great is Your mercy and lovingkindness toward me. You have delivered my soul from the depths of the dead.

Psalms 103:1-5 Bless the Lord, O my soul; and all that is within me, bless Your holy name! Bless the Lord, O my soul: I will not forget any of Your benefits; You forgive all my sins, You heal all my diseases, You redeem my life from destruction, You crown me with lovingkindness and compassion, You satisfy my desires with good things, so that my youth is renewed like the eagle.

Proverbs 28:13 He who covers his sins will not be blessed; but whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy.

Psalms 119:140, 148 Your promises have been thoroughly tested; that is why I love them so much. I stay awake through the night, thinking about Your promise.

Psalms 103:17-18 Your lovingkindness is from everlasting to everlasting on me, and Your righteousness to my children's children. You have established Your throne in heaven and Your kingdom rules overall.

Proverbs 12:14 I will be satisfied with good by the fruit of my words, and the deeds of my hands will return to me.

Proverbs 22:17 I will incline my ear and hear the words of the wise and apply my heart to knowledge. For it will be pleasant if I keep them within me, that they may be ready on my lips, so that my trust may be in the Lord.

Psalms 107:1 I give thanks to You, Lord for You are good, for Your lovingkindness is everlasting.

1 Timothy 1:12 I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has strengthened me because He considered me faithful, putting me into service.

Hebrews 6:13-20 Our great desire is that you will keep on loving others as long as life lasts, in order to make certain that what you hope for will come true. Then you will not become spiritually dull and indifferent.

Instead, you will follow the example of those who are going to inherit God's promises because of their faith and endurance. For example, there was God's promise to Abraham. Since there was no one greater to swear by, God took an oath in His own name, saying: "I will certainly bless you, and I will multiply your descendants beyond number." Then Abraham waited patiently, and he received what God had promised. Now when people take an oath, they call on someone greater than themselves to hold them to it. And without any question that oath is binding. God also bound Himself with an oath, so that those who received the promise could be perfectly sure that He would never change His mind. So God has given both His promise and His oath.

These two things are unchangeable because it is impossible for God to lie. Therefore, we who have fled to Him for refuge can have great confidence as we hold to the hope that lies before us. This hope is a strong and trustworthy anchor for our souls.

Psalms 119:105 Your Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light to my path.

Psalms 119:11 Your Word have I hidden in my heart, that I may not sin against you.

John 15:16 (Jesus said), "You did not choose Me; I chose you. And I gave you this work: to go and produce fruit, fruit that will last. Then the Father will give you anything you ask for in My name."

Philippians 2:13 It is God who is at work in me, both to will and to work for His good pleasure.

Philippians 1:6 For I am confident of this very thing, that God who began a good work in me will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus.

1 John 3:22 God gives us what we ask for because we obey God's commands and do what pleases Him.

Psalms 121:2-8 My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth! You will not let me stumble; the one who watches over me will not slumber. Indeed, You watch over Israel and never slumber or sleep. The Lord Himself watches over me! The Lord stands beside me as my protective shade. The sun will not harm me by day, nor the moon at night. The Lord keeps me from all harm and watches my life. The Lord keeps watch over me as I come and go, both now and forever.

Isaiah 43:2 When I pass through the waters, You will be with me; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow me. When I walk through the fires, I shall not be burned, nor shall the flame scorch me.

Psalms 4:8 I will both lie down in peace and sleep, for You alone, O Lord, make me dwell in safety.

1 John 4:9-10 This is how God showed His love to us: He sent His one and only Son into the world so that we could have life through Him. This is what real love is: It is not our love for God; it is God's love for us. He sent His Son to die in our place to take away our sins.

1 John 4:16 I have known and believed the love that God has for me. God is love, and as I abide in love, I abide in God, and God in me.

2 Corinthians 1:4 The Holy Spirit comforts us in all our troubles so that we can comfort others.

Romans 15:5-6 Now may the God of patience and comfort grant us to be like-minded toward one another, according to Christ Jesus, that we may with one mind and one mouth glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Psalms 138:2-3 I praise Your name for Your unfailing love and faithfulness; for Your promises are backed by all the honor of Your name. As soon as I pray, You answer me; You encourage me by giving me strength.

Proverbs 19:16 Keep the commandments and keep your life; despising them leads to death.

Joshua 23:14 Not one word has failed of all the good things that the Lord my God promised concerning me. All have come to pass for me; not one of them has failed.

Psalms 107:19-22 "Lord, help!" I cry in my trouble, and You save me from my distress. You send out Your Word and heal me, snatching me from the door of death. I will praise the Lord for Your great love and for the wonderful things You have done for me. I will offer sacrifices of thanksgiving and sing joyfully about Your glorious acts.

Isaiah 40:31 Those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

Romans 15:13 I pray that the God who gives hope will fill you with much joy and peace while you trust in Him. Then your hope will overflow by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Hebrews 13:16 Do not forget to do good to others, and share with them, because such sacrifices please God.

Isaiah 41:10 I will not fear, for You are with me; I will not be dismayed, for You are my God. You will strengthen me and help me; You will uphold me with Your righteous right hand.

Exodus 14:14 The Lord Himself will fight for you. Just stay calm.

Proverbs 4:10 My child, listen to me and do as I say, and you will have a long, good life.

Proverbs 21:21 Whoever pursues righteousness and unfailing love will find life, righteousness, and honor.

Deuteronomy 6:24-25 The Lord our God commanded us to obey all these decrees and to fear Him so He can continue to bless us and preserve our lives, as He has done to this day. For we will be counted as righteous when we obey all the commands the Lord our God has given us.

Ezekiel 36:25-26 For I will gather you up from all the nations and bring you home again to your land. Then I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you will be clean. Your filth will be washed away, and you will no longer worship idols. And I will give you a new heart, and I will put a new spirit in you. I will take out your stony, stubborn heart and give you a tender, responsive heart.

Job 36:11 If they listen and obey God, they will be blessed with prosperity throughout their lives. All their years will be pleasant.

James 1:5, 12 If you need wisdom, ask our generous God, and He will give it to you. He will not rebuke you for asking. God blesses those who patiently endure testing and temptation. Afterward they will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love Him.

James 4:6–7 God gives grace to the humble. Therefore, submit yourselves to God, resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Hebrews 6:13-20 When God made His promise to Abraham, He backed it to the hilt, putting His own reputation on the line. He said, "I promise that I'll bless you with everything I have—bless and bless!"

Abraham stuck it out and got everything that had been promised to him. When people make promises, they guarantee them by appeal to some authority above them so that if there is any question that they'll make good on the promise, the authority will back them up.

When God wanted to guarantee His promises, He gave His Word, a rock-solid guarantee—God can't break His Word. And because His Word cannot change, the promise is likewise unchangeable.

We who have run for our very lives to God have every reason to grab the promised hope with both hands and never let go. It's an unbreakable spiritual lifeline, reaching past all appearances right to the very presence of God where Jesus, running on ahead of us, has taken up His permanent post as high priest for us. (The Message)

Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

2 Chronicles 7:14 If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

Isaiah 54:10-20 "For the mountains may move and the hills disappear, but even then My faithful love for you will remain. My covenant of blessing will never be broken," says the Lord, who has mercy on you. "O storm-battered city, troubled and desolate! I will rebuild you with precious jewels and make your foundations from lapis. I will make your towers of sparkling rubies, your gates of shining gems, and your walls of precious stones. I will teach all your children, and they will enjoy great peace. You will be secure under a government that is just and fair. Your enemies will stay far away.

You will live in peace, and terror will not come near. If any nation comes to fight you, it is not because I sent them.

Whoever attacks you will go down in defeat. I have created the blacksmith who fans the coals beneath the forge and makes the weapons of destruction. And I have created the armies that destroy. But in that coming day no weapon turned against you will succeed. You will silence every voice raised up to accuse you. These benefits are enjoyed by the servants of the Lord; their vindication will come from me. I, the Lord, have spoken!"

Philippians 4:19 And my God will supply all our needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.

Acts 1:8 (Jesus said), "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem and Judea and Samaria and to the ends of the earth."

Deuteronomy 30:15-20 (God says), "Today I am giving you a choice between life and death, between prosperity and disaster. For I command you this day to love the Lord your God and to keep His commands, decrees, and regulations by walking in His ways. If you do this, you will live and multiply, and the Lord your God will bless you and the land you are about to enter and occupy. But if your heart turns away and you refuse to listen, and if you are drawn away to serve and worship other gods, then I warn you now that you will certainly be destroyed.

You will not live a long, good life in the land you are crossing the Jordan to occupy. Today I have given you the choice between life and death, between blessings and curses. Now I call on heaven and earth to witness the choice you make. Oh, that you would choose life, so that you and your descendants might live! You can make this choice by loving the Lord your God, obeying Him, and committing yourself firmly to Him. This is the key to your life. And if you love and obey the Lord, you will live long in the land the Lord swore to give your ancestors Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob."

Deuteronomy 8:18 Remember the Lord your God. He is the one who gives you power to be successful, in order to fulfill the covenant He confirmed to your ancestors with an oath.

Malachi 3:10 "Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so there will be enough food in my Temple. If you do," says the Lord of Heaven's Armies, "I will open the windows of heaven for you. I will pour out a blessing so great you won't have enough room to take it in! Try it! Put me to the test!"

John 15:5-8 (Jesus said), "Jam the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in Me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from Me you can do nothing. Anyone who does not remain in Me is thrown away like a useless branch and withers. Such branches are gathered into a pile to be burned. But if you remain in Me and My Words remain in you, you may ask for anything you want, and it will be granted! When you produce much fruit, you are My true disciples. This brings great glory to my Father."

Mark 11:22-25 Jesus answered, "Have faith in God. I tell you the truth, you can say to this mountain, 'Go, fall into the sea.' And if you have no doubts in your mind and believe that what you say will happen, God will do it for you. So I tell you to believe that you have received the things you ask for in prayer, and God will give them to you. When you are praying, if you are angry with someone, forgive him so that your Father in heaven will also forgive your sins.

Psalms 18:3 I called to the Lord, who is worthy of praise, and I have been saved from my enemies.

Joshua 1:8-9 Study this Book of Instruction continually. Meditate on it day and night so you will be sure to obey everything written in it. Only then will you prosper and succeed in all you do. This is my command—be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid or discouraged. For the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.

Psalms 37:4 Delight yourself in the Lord, and He shall give you the desires of your heart.

Psalms 50:15 (God says), "Call on Me when you are in trouble, and I will rescue you, and you will give Me glory."

Revelation 3:5 All who are victorious will be clothed in white. You will never erase our names from the Book of Life, but You will announce before Your Father and His angels that we are Yours.

2 Corinthians 1:3-4 Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. God is the Father who is full of mercy and all comfort. He comforts us every time we have trouble, so when others have trouble, we can comfort them with the same comfort God gives us.

Romans 10:9-10 If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved.

1 Peter 2:24 He personally carried our sins in His body on the cross so that we can be dead to sin and live for what is right. By His wounds you are healed.

Philippians 4:6-7 Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank Him for all He has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus.

James 5:14-15 Are any of you sick? You should call for the elders of the church to come and pray over you, anointing you with oil in the name of the Lord. Such a prayer offered in faith will heal the sick, and the Lord will make you well. And if you have committed any sins, you will be forgiven.

Matthew 6:31-33 Don't worry about these things, saying, "What will we eat? What will we drink? What will we wear?" These things dominate the thoughts of unbelievers, but your heavenly Father already knows all your needs. Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and He will give you everything you need.

Luke 11:9-10 And so I tell you, keep on asking, and you will receive what you ask for. Keep on seeking, and you will find. Keep on knocking, and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks, receives. Everyone who seeks, finds. And to everyone who knocks, the door will be opened.

Luke 9:1 One day Jesus called together His twelve disciples and gave them power and authority to cast out all demons and to heal all diseases.

Jeremiah 17:7-8 Blessed are those who trust in the Lord and have made the Lord their hope and confidence. They are like trees planted along a riverbank, with roots that reach deep into the water. Such trees are not bothered by the heat or worried by long months of drought. Their leaves stay green, and they never stop producing fruit.

Isaiah 26:3-4 You keep us in perfect peace as our mind is stayed on You, because we trust in You.

2 Thessalonians 3:3, 5 The Lord is faithful and will give you strength and will protect you from the evil one. May the Lord lead your hearts into God's love and Christ's patience.
