



Proverbs 3:5 Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will direct your paths.

Deuteronomy 5:16 Honor your father and your mother, as the Lord your God has commanded you, that your days may be long, and that it may be well with you in the land which the Lord your God is giving you.

Psalms 103:1-5 I will bless the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me. I will bless His holy name. I will not forget any of God's benefits, He forgives all my sins, He heals all my diseases, He redeems my life from destruction, He crowns me with lovingkindness and compassion, and He satisfies my desires with good things, so that my youth is renewed like the eagle.

2 Corinthians 4:8-10 We are pressed on every side by troubles, but we are not crushed. We are perplexed, but not driven to despair. We are hunted down, but never abandoned by God. We get knocked down, but we are not destroyed. Through suffering, our bodies continue to share in the death of Jesus so that the life of Jesus may also be seen in our bodies.

Galatians 2:20 My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. So I live in this earthly body by trusting in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.

Philippians 4:6-7 Do not worry about anything, but pray and ask God for everything you need, always giving thanks. And God's peace, which is so great we cannot understand it, will keep your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 4:29 When you talk, do not say harmful things, but say what people need—words that will help others become stronger. Then what you say will do good to those who listen to you.

Proverbs 4:20-27 My child, pay attention to My Words; listen closely to what I say. Don't ever forget My Words; keep them always in mind. They are the key to life for those who find them; they bring health to the whole body. Be careful what you think, because your thoughts run your life.

Don't use your mouth to tell lies; don't ever say things that are not true. Keep your eyes focused on what is right, and look straight ahead to what is good. Be careful what you do, and always do what is right. Don't turn off the road of goodness; keep away from evil paths.

Psalms 34:1 I will bless the Lord at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.

Psalms 34:7 For the angel of the Lord is a guard; He surrounds and defends all who fear Him.

Proverbs 13:20 He who walks with wise men will be wise, but the companion of fools will be destroyed.

Psalms 34:8-19 Taste and see that the Lord is good. Oh, the joys of those who take refuge in Him! Fear the Lord, you His godly people, for those who fear Him will have all they need. Even strong young lions sometimes go hungry, but those who trust in the Lord will lack no good thing.

Come, my children, and listen to Me, and I will teach you to fear the Lord. Does anyone want to live a life that is long and prosperous? Then keep your tongue from speaking evil and your lips from telling lies! Turn away from evil and do good. Search for peace, and work to maintain it. The eyes of the Lord watch over those who do right; His ears are open to their cries for help. But the Lord turns His face against those who do evil; He will erase their memory from the earth.

The Lord hears His people when they call to Him for help. He rescues them from all their troubles. The Lord is close to the brokenhearted; He rescues those whose spirits are crushed. The righteous person faces many troubles, but the Lord comes to the rescue each time.

Proverbs 21:21 As I pursue righteousness and loyalty, I will find life, righteousness, and honor.

Proverbs 22:1 A good name is to be more desired than great riches. Favor is better than silver and gold.

Proverbs 22:4 True humility and fear of the Lord lead to riches, honor, and long life.

Proverbs 22:17-18 Listen to the words of the wise; apply your heart to My instruction. For it is good to keep these sayings in your heart and always ready on your lips.

Proverbs 12:2 The Lord is pleased with a good person, but He will punish anyone who plans evil.

Proverbs 3:1-26 My child, do not forget My teaching, but keep My commands in mind.

Then you will live a long time, and your life will be successful. Don't ever forget kindness and truth. Wear them like a necklace. Write them on your heart as if on a tablet. Then you will be respected and will please both God and people. Trust the Lord with all your heart, and don't depend on your own understanding.

Remember the Lord in all you do, and He will give you success. Don't depend on your own wisdom. Respect the Lord and refuse to do wrong. Then your body will be healthy, and your bones will be strong. Honor the Lord with your wealth and the first fruits from all your crops.

Then your barns will be full, and your wine barrels will overflow with new wine. My child, do not reject the Lord's discipline, and don't get angry when He corrects you. The Lord corrects those He loves, just as parents correct the child they delight in. Happy is the person who finds wisdom, the one who gets understanding. Wisdom is worth more than silver; it brings more profit than gold.

Wisdom is more precious than rubies; nothing you could want is equal to it. With her right hand wisdom offers you a long life, and with her left hand she gives you riches and honor. Wisdom will make your life pleasant and will bring you peace. As a tree produces fruit, wisdom gives life to those who use it, and everyone who uses it will be happy.

The Lord made the earth, using His wisdom. He set the sky in place, using His understanding. With His knowledge, He made springs flow into rivers and the clouds drop rain on the earth. My child, hold on to wisdom and good sense. Don't let them out of your sight. They will give you life and beauty like a necklace around your neck.

Then you will go your way in safety, and you will not get hurt. When you lie down, you won't be afraid; when you lie down, you will sleep in peace. You won't be afraid of sudden trouble; you won't fear the ruin that comes to the wicked, because the Lord will keep you safe. He will keep you from being trapped.

Ephesians 1:4 Even before God made the world, He loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in His eyes.

Proverbs 13:15 People with good understanding will be well liked, but the lives of those who are not trustworthy are hard.

Proverbs 16:6-9 Love and truth bring forgiveness of sin. By respecting the Lord you will avoid evil. When people live so that they please the Lord, even their enemies will make peace with them.

It is better to be poor and right than to be wealthy and dishonest. People may make plans in their minds, but the Lord decides what they will do.

Proverbs 16:16 How much better to get wisdom than gold and to get understanding is to be chosen above silver.

Proverbs 16:32 Patience is better than strength. Controlling your temper is better than capturing a city.

Psalms 5:8 Lead me in the right path, O Lord, or my enemies will conquer me. Make Your way plain for me to follow.

Psalms 1:1-3 Happy are those who don't listen to the wicked, who don't go where sinners go, who don't do what evil people do. They love the Lord's teachings, and they think about those teachings day and night. They are strong, like a tree planted by a river. The tree produces fruit in season, and its leaves don't die. Everything they do will succeed.

Psalms 31:1-3 Lord, I trust in You; let me never be disgraced. Save me because You do what is right. Listen to me and save me quickly. Be my rock of protection, a strong city to save me. You are my rock and my protection. For the good of Your name, lead me and guide me.

Psalms 31:16 Make Your face shine upon Your servant, save me for Your mercies' sake.

Psalms 34:12-15 Does anyone want to live a life that is long and prosperous? Then keep your tongue from speaking evil and your lips from telling lies! Turn away from evil and do good. Search for peace, and work to maintain it. The eyes of the Lord watch over those who do right; His ears are open to their cries for help.

Psalms 34:22 You redeem the soul of Your servants, and none of those who trust in You will be condemned.

Romans 8:1-3 So now there is no condemnation for those who belong to Christ Jesus.

And because you belong to Him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death. The law of Moses was unable to save us because of the weakness of our sinful nature. So God did what the law could not do. He sent His own Son in a body like the bodies we sinners have. And in that body God declared an end to sin's control over us by giving His Son as a sacrifice for our sins.

Psalms 31:22 In my distress, I said, "God cannot see me!" But You heard my prayer when I cried out to You for help.

Psalms 37:1-11 Don't worry about the wicked or envy those who do wrong. For like grass, they soon fade away. Like spring flowers, they soon wither.

Trust in the Lord and do good. Then you will live safely in the land and prosper. Take delight in the Lord, and He will give you your heart's desires. Commit everything you do to the Lord. Trust Him, and He will help you. He will make your innocence radiate like the dawn, and the justice of your cause will shine like the noonday sun. Be still in the presence of the Lord, and wait patiently for Him to act. Don't worry about evil people who prosper or fret about their wicked schemes. Stop being angry! Turn from your rage! Do not lose your temper—it only leads to harm. For the wicked will be destroyed, but those who trust in the Lord will possess the land. Soon the wicked will disappear. Though you look for them, they will be gone. The humble will possess the land and will live in peace and prosperity.

Psalms 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

Proverbs 15:1-2 A gentle answer turns away anger, but a harsh word stirs up anger. The tongue of the wise uses knowledge rightly, but the mouth of fools pours forth foolishness.

Proverbs 15:7 The lips of the wise spread knowledge, but the hearts of fools are not so.

Proverbs 15:23 A man has joy in an apt answer, and how delightful is a timely word.

Proverbs 15:28 The heart of the righteous studies how to answer, but the mouth of the wicked pours out evil things.

Proverbs 17:1 Better is a dry piece of toast and quietness with it than a house full of feasting with strife.

Proverbs 17:9-10 Whoever forgives someone's sin makes a friend, but gossiping about the sin breaks up friendships. A wise person will learn more from a warning than a fool will learn from a hundred lashings.

Proverbs 19:1 It is better to be poor and honest than to be foolish and tell lies.

1 Corinthians 13:4-7 Love is patient and kind. Love is not jealous or boastful or proud or rude. It does not demand its own way. It is not irritable, and it keeps no record of being wronged.

It does not rejoice about injustice but rejoices whenever the truth wins out. Love never gives up, never loses faith, is always hopeful, and endures through every circumstance.

1 Corinthians 13:9-13 Now our knowledge is partial and incomplete, and even the gift of prophecy reveals only part of the whole picture! But when the time of perfection comes, these partial things will become useless. When I was a child, I spoke and thought and reasoned as a child. But when I grew up, I put away childish things. Now we see things imperfectly, like puzzling reflections in a mirror, but then we will see everything with perfect clarity. All that I know now is partial and incomplete, but then I will know everything completely, just as God now knows me completely. Three things will last forever faith, hope, and love—and the greatest of these is love.

John 14:15-17 (Jesus said), "If you love Me, you will obey My commands. I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper to be with you forever - the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept Him, because it does not see Him or know Him. But you know Him, because He lives with you and He will be in you."

Proverbs 19:8 To acquire wisdom is to love yourself; people who cherish understanding will prosper.

John 14:23 Jesus replied, "All who love Me will do what I say. My Father will love them, and We will come and make Our home with each of them."

Proverbs 21:23 Watch your tongue and keep your mouth shut, and you will stay out of trouble.

Matthew 7:20-27 (Jesus said), "Just as you can identify a tree by its fruit, so you can identify people by their actions. Not everyone who calls out to Me, 'Lord! Lord!' will enter the Kingdom of Heaven. Only those who actually do the will of My Father in heaven will enter. On judgment day many will say to Me, 'Lord! Lord! We prophesied in Your name and cast out demons in Your name and performed many miracles in Your name.' But I will reply, 'I never knew you. Get away from Me, you who break God's laws.' Anyone who listens to My teaching and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house on solid rock.

Though the rain comes in torrents and the floodwaters rise and the winds beat against that house, it won't collapse because it is built on bedrock. But anyone who hears My teaching and doesn't obey it is foolish, like a person who builds a house on sand. When the rains and floods come and the winds beat against that house, it will collapse with a mighty crash."

Proverbs 19:11 A man's discretion makes him slow to anger, and it is his glory to overlook a sin.

Ephesians 5:10-11 Carefully determine what pleases the Lord. Take no part in the worthless deeds of evil and darkness; instead, expose them.

Proverbs 19:20-21 Listen to advice and accept correction, and in the end you will be wise. People can make all kinds of plans, but only the Lord's plan will happen.

Ephesians 5:15-20 So be careful how you live. Don't live like fools, but like those who are wise. Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days. Don't act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you to do. Don't be drunk with wine, because that will ruin your life. Instead, be filled with the Holy Spirit, singing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs among yourselves, and making music to the Lord in your hearts. And give thanks for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

John 8:31-32 So Jesus said to the Jews who believed in Him, "If you continue to obey My teaching, you are truly My followers. Then you will know the truth, and the truth will make you free."

Proverbs 28:13 If you hide your sins, you will not succeed. If you confess and reject them, you will receive mercy.

Proverbs 19:16 Keep the commandments and keep your life; despising them leads to death.

1 Thessalonians 5:15-18 See that no one pays back evil for evil, but always try to do good to each other and to all people. Always be joyful. Never stop praying. Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus.

Proverbs 15:31-33 If you listen to constructive criticism, you will be at home among the wise. If you reject discipline, you only harm yourself; but if you listen to correction, you grow in understanding. Fear of the Lord teaches wisdom; humility precedes honor.

Matthew 6:14-15 If you forgive those who sin against you, your heavenly Father will forgive you. But if you refuse to forgive others, your Father will not forgive your sins.

Ephesians 4:24-26 Put on your new nature, created to be like God—truly righteous and holy. So stop telling lies. Let us tell our neighbors the truth, for we are all parts of the same body.

And don't sin by letting anger control you. Don't let the sun go down while you are still angry,

Ephesians 4:1-6 Therefore I, a prisoner for serving the Lord, beg you to lead a life worthy of your calling, for you have been called by God. Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, making allowance for each other's faults because of your love. Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace. For there is one body and one Spirit, just as you have been called to one glorious hope for the future. There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is over all, in all, and living through all.
